Behind every number is a person in need. Across the UK, 1,671 food banks in the Trussell network are providing vital support to those facing severe financial hardship. Over the past year, more than 2.6 million people received emergency food parcels, 45% higher than pre-pandemic levels, showing just how many individuals and families are still struggling.
